Methodology

Vital statistics

Registrars collect and distribute the data on births, deaths and contracted marriages and the courts of respective jurisdiction collect the data on dissolved marriages. The Ministry of interior, the residence registration service provides the data on migrations.

Statistics of births cover all births (live births and stillborns) and statistics of deaths cover any death case in the respective year.

Statistics of contracted marriages cover the legally concluded marriages that are entered in registers of marriages. **Statistics of dissolved marriages (divorces)** cover the marriages that were legally dissolved (by decree absolute), cancelled or made void.

Population migrations stand for the population moves from native place or the previous place of residence to another place of residence. Short or long stays at another place due to work or schooling are not considered as moves.

Population ageing index represents the ratio of the population aged 60 and over and the population aged 0-19.

Life expectancy stands for the average age that a live birth is expected to live to, i.e. the average number of years lived, supposing that the conditions of mortality would be identical as when creating mortality tables.

Total fertility rate is expressed as the total number of live births per a woman of fertile age, in the respective year.

2002 Census

When using the census data it should be noted that the definitions of constant, i.e. total population applied in the 2002 Census and in previous censuses are not fully comparable. In the censuses of 1971, 1981 and 1991, apart from the population residing in the country, the constant population



comprised also the Yugoslav citizens working abroad and also their family members who stayed with them abroad.

Pursuant to the international recommendations (the Recommendations for the 2000 Censuses of population and housing in the ECE region, New York and Geneva, 1998), in the 2002 Census the constant population comprised, apart from the population residing in the country, the Yugoslav citizens working, i.e. living abroad for less than a year and also the foreign citizens who work or live as family members in our country for more than a year.

The data on **age** are expressed in whole years of age and for the infants under one year in whole months.

Just as before, in the 2002 Census the data on **educational attainment** relate to the highest educational level attained, i.e. the school that a person graduated from and thereby merited educational attainment. The data on educational attainment did not cover preschool children and primary school children.

Literate persons are the persons of the age 10 and over, who completed more than three grades of primary school. Also as literate persons we considered the persons that accomplished one to three grades of primary school and the persons without education who were able to write and read a short text on everyday life.

The data on **marital status** relates to the formal, legal marital status of a person.

Active population comprises the persons aged 15 and over with work occupation and also the unemployed persons seeking job and the persons who left job in order to do military service. **The persons with personal income** have sustenance provided from regular receipts, such as pension (old-age, disablement and family pensions), real estate related income (house, flat, shop renting, etc.) or other personal income (alimentation, welfare benefits, grants, etc.). **Supported population** consists of the persons with no personal income of any kind or those who receive inconsiderable means and are mainly supported by parents, relations or legal persons.

Sources and methods of data collection

The data are collected by the surveys: the Quarterly survey of construction (Gradj-31), the Semiannual review of the prices of new-constructed dwellings, (Gradj-41), the Annual review of construction and engineering material consumption (Gradj-13), the Annual survey of construction works (Gradj-11), the Annual review of individual proprietors constructions (Gradj-11a).

Coverage

The quarterly survey of construction covers the construction works that in the respective year conducted the legal persons classified under construction activity, the section F-Construction, the legal persons not classified under construction activity but that feature composite units active in construction. The quarterly survey of construction does not cover all enterprises. The semiannual review of the prices of new-constructed dwellings covers the new-constructed and sold dwellings, i.e. the dwellings that are subject of executed purchase agreements. The annual review of construction and engineering material consumption refers to the construction and engineering material that the construction contractors (construction companies and other) use for constructions, maintenance, overhauling and operation of machinery and vehicles, as fuels and as office and other supplementary material. The data on the number of accomplished and unaccomplished dwellings are collected by the Annual review of construction works, which is provided by all legal persons classified under construction activity, the section F-Construction, and the legal persons not classified under construction activity but featuring composite units active in construction. Here included are also the data on dwelling constructions executed by individual proprietors.

Definitions

The value of the works carried out in the respective quarter, the hours worked at construction sites and the average number of workers at construction sites are presented by the territory where the constructions are located and not by the location of the contractors' head office and these data cover the construction activity of contractors from the Republic of Serbia and the Republic of Montenegro. Dwelling is any construction unit for dwelling purpose that consists of one or several rooms with respective accompanying premises (kitchen, bathrooms, hall, pantry, toilet, etc.) or without accompanying premises and it may feature one or several separate entrances. Dwelling floor space is the usable floor area inside the dwelling walls. Accomplished dwelling is the dwelling with the wholly accomplished construction works, installations and final works.
